


What Would You Eat?

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

KEY PASSAGE: 1 Chronicles 16:31

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:
• What is the gospel? The gospel is the good news that God sent His Son, Jesus, into the world to rescue sinners.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:
• Who did God show Peter the good news is for?
• What happened when Peter told Cornelius and Cornelius' friends and family about Jesus?
• Who is someone you can tell the good news of Jesus?


FAMILY ACTIVITY:

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:
• More and more Gentiles heard and believed the good news about Jesus.
• The gospel continued to spread.
• The church in Jerusalem sent Barnabas to visit and encourage the new believers in Antioch.

KEY PASSAGE: 1 Chronicles 16:31

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:
• What is the gospel? The gospel is the good news that God sent His Son, Jesus, into the world to rescue sinners.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:
• How does the gospel spread?
• Can anything stop the gospel from spreading? Why or why not?
• How should we respond when people put their trust in Jesus?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:
• Identify someone who has recently trusted in Jesus. Ask your church staff for suggestions. Assemble a "party in a box" as a family. Deliver the party box to the new believer.
• Arrange dominoes in such a way that when one is pushed over, all the others follow. Talk about how the gospel goes from person to person in a similar way.

• Why is Jesus the only true hero of the Bible?


FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Why does following Jesus give a person true joy?


FAMILY ACTIVITY:

FAMILY ACTIVITY:


- Identify someone your family knows who has a great need. Pray for the situation daily as a family, asking God to help.

- How can people who are different from one another come together?


FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- How does knowing Jesus loves us help us do what is good?


FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Who is the good news about Jesus for?


FAMILY ACTIVITY:

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Paul and Silas told many people about Jesus.
- God saved a woman named Lydia.
- God saved a jailer.
- Paul told the people in Athens about Jesus and some believed.

KEY PASSAGE: Acts 4:12

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- What is the Bible about? The Bible is about God's plan to save people through Jesus.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- How would you have felt if you were the jailer and woke to find all the jail doors open?
- How did Lydia hear about Jesus? The jailer? People in Athens?
- How do people hear the good news about Jesus? Who is someone you can tell?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Collect soft covered Bibles to donate to a prison ministry.
- If possible, visit a river as a family. Pray together by the river. Talk about how Paul and Silas had gone to the river to pray when they met Lydia and told her about Jesus.

No Other Gospel

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- The people in the church in Galatia believed lies from false teachers.
- Paul taught that believers are saved by faith in Jesus alone.
- We become Christians and live as Christians by faith.
- Obeying rules does not make us right with God.

KEY PASSAGE: Acts 4:12

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- What is the Bible about? The Bible is about God's plan to save people through Jesus.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- Why did the Galatian believers believe the lies of the false teachers?
- Paul called the Galatian believers "foolish." Why did Paul use such a strong word?
- How do we live by faith?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Be extra sensitive this week to notice when your children try to win your favor through their obedience. Remind them that while obedience is good, you love them apart from their works.

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What Happens Next?

INSTRUCTIONS: Number each scene with 1, 2, or 3 to show what happened first, next, and last.



BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Paul sent Timothy to visit the believers in Thessalonica.
- They did not give up even though following Jesus was not easy.
- Paul wrote to the Thessalonian believers to encourage them.
- Paul wrote that believers have hope because Jesus will come again.

KEY PASSAGE: Acts 4:12

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

- What is the Bible about? The Bible is about God's plan to save people through Jesus.

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- Name a time following Jesus was hard for you.
- How does knowing Jesus will come back one day give you hope?
- What makes you most excited about Jesus coming back?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Play a "guess the future" game by predicting that something will happen that day. Evaluate each family members' guess that evening. Talk about how Jesus' return is sure because the Bible tells us so.



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
